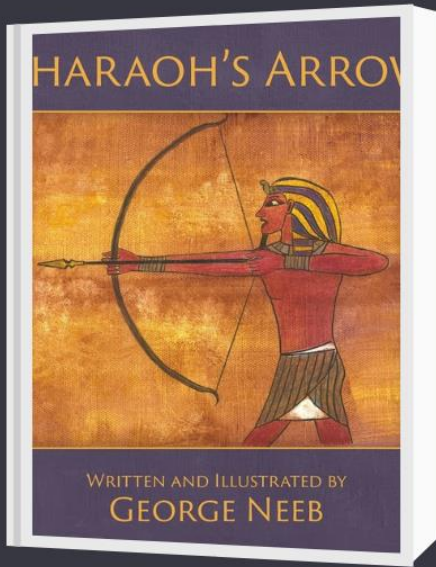

LESSON PACK NOTES

Watch the read aloud of **Pharaoh's Arrow** by the author himself here: <https://bit.ly/3i8R6j6>.

Read the book aloud to the children and explore the images.

Prompt recall of the text using the retrieval questions on the slides. Introduce the summarised statements along with the images first. Children are to repeat each statement and tell their partner. Do this repetitively until the story sticks with the readers.

Show the first slide with the jumbled images and the text in the correct order. Give children the activity sheet to order the images and match them to the text.

Go through the correct order by drawing lines on the smart board from the statements to the correct image. Children then do the higher challenge activity sheet with partners. They are to cut out the images and stick them in the template sheet. For increased challenge do the storyteller activity which goes with the matching and sequencing sheets also differentiated for challenge.
