LESSON PACK NOTES

Watch the read aloud by the author Denise Lawson here: <https://bit.ly/2TJ9IN6>. Read the full text with the children and explore the images.

Using the slides tell the children they are going to put some of the story in order using time words to help them to retell some of the text. Model through the use of time words using the slides. Teaching them how to order the vocabulary giving examples of how they are used in everyday language. Read through some of the text and link to the time ordered words and summary statements. Go through the main events of the story repetitively until children can retell verbally. Move on to differentiated sheets. The lower challenge matching sheets should be tackled first before moving on to the higher.
