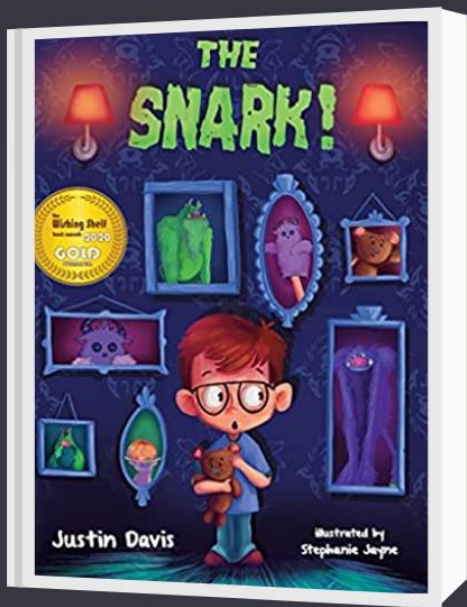

LESSON PACK NOTES

Watch the read aloud of a part of *The Snark* by the author himself here: <https://bit.ly/3iRvzuu>. Read the book aloud to the children and get them to join in with the repetitive line.. ('What's a Snark?' I hear you cry.)

The descriptions have some misconceptions in vocabulary worth exploring with pupils. Be sure to ask how they know the words they use to describe the Snark is correct and why the ones eliminated are not correct.

Describing the boy is a harder activity as children will need to explore vocabulary. Use an age appropriate dictionary resource to help them identify meanings and model how they can do this with a partner.

As an extra activity children can incorporate Mathematical 2D shapes to develop their own monster. The worksheet means you can avoid using the book but children can refer to the pages at the back as a guide.
